

RALPH LAUREN PAINT

REGENT METALLICS HOW-TO GUIDE

Inspired by military and heraldic trim, this collection of luminous paint adds shimmering richness to classic colors, introducing a new level of luxury and custom detail to a room



BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

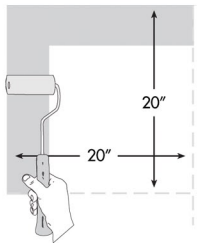
Start with clean, dry walls primed with latex primer.

STEP 1: TAPE

Apply tape along any surface bordering the painting area.

STEP 2: EDGES

Rinse the roller covers and squeeze out the excess water to remove any lint. Saturate the rollers in Regent Metallics.



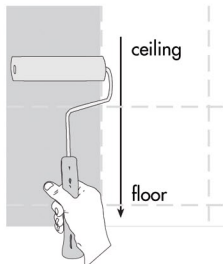
Starting at the left top corner, use the small roller to paint a 20" square.

Fill in the square using the large roller, overlapping strokes no more than 1/4" to blend with the border.

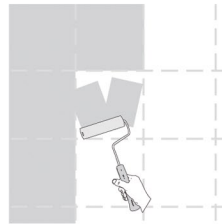
Continue directly down the wall in 20" squares until you have created a column that reaches the full height of the wall.

Reload the rollers after completing each square.

When the column is complete, blend the roller lines by gently sweeping the large roller from ceiling to floor without reloading it.



Repeat the process creating adjacent columns with no more than 1/4" overlap. When you near the end of the wall, use the small roller to reach the corners.



STEP 3: FINAL COAT

Allow the base coat to dry for at least four hours and then apply the final coat using the same steps as the base coat.

Allow the final coat to dry for at least four hours before removing the tape.

DESIGN TIP

For an elegant accent, complement an ordinary wall by treating just the trim with Regent Metallics. Tape the wall and ceiling, then use a small, soft brush to complete two coats.

What you will need:



AMPLE PAINT
One gallon of Regent Metallics covers approximately 200 square feet with two coats
